

SNP Minecraft Code of Conduct

Our main intention on SNP Minecraft is to keep the players safe, while providing a place for them to play and enjoy themselves. Please read through the following information, and keep in mind the points made when participating, as anyone not respecting these guidelines will be removed from the SNP Minecraft server and SNP Zoom session, with or without warning!

Players that choose to participate in SNP Minecraft sessions agree to abide by the following points:

Stay on topic - We are here for the purpose of playing together on the SNP Minecraft server only.

Active Participation – It is expected that when players are in the SNP Minecraft session, they will only be using the SNP Minecraft server and SNP Zoom meeting when online. If players are no longer actively participating in the session they will be asked to leave, and/or may be disconnected from the server and Zoom session with or without notice.

Respect for others - It is expected that all participants be courteous, considerate and respectful of others.

Communication - All types of chat must be within the public settings of the group.

Following directions – If admins or moderators make a request, it is expected that participants follow them for the sake of the group.

Please refer to the SNP Minecraft server in-game guidelines on the SNP Minecraft website as well!

Please note that the SNP Minecraft Zoom session will be recorded.

The following settings apply to Zoom for the SNP Minecraft session:

Chat - Host only: Only the host can send messages to everyone. Participants can still send private messages to the host. Therefore no private messaging will be possible.

Screen Share – Host Only: Only Host will share a screen, if necessary.

TIP: Zoom participants have the option to have their video turned off in their personal settings if preferred.
